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ORDER:

In her D.O.letter first read above, the Commissioner of Civil Supplies and Consumer Protection has informed the Government that it was suggested by the Voluntary Consumer Organisations that all the Government Departments and Government agencies which are connected with consumer Affairs should organise regular meetings with voluntary consumer organisations so as to enable these organisations to represent their grievances to the appropriate officials. The Commissioner of Civil Supplies and Consumer Protection has therefore recommended the above proposal and suggested that necessary orders may be issued by the Government advising all Secretaries to Government/Heads of Departments/Government undertakings to organise Periodical meetings (not less than four meetings in a year) with all the Voluntary (non-Governmental) Consumer Organisations, to hear their grievances/suggestions/recommendations and take appropriate follow-up action on such matters put forward by the organisations. In her letter third read above, she has furnished a list of leading voluntary consumer organisations with whom such meetings may be organised.

2. The Government have carefully examined the above proposal and direct that all Secretaries to Government/Heads of Departments/Government undertakings concerned with Consumer affairs should organise regular meetings with the leading voluntary (non-Governmental)/Consumer Organisations annexed to this order (not less than four meetings in a year) so as to enable these organisations to represent their grievances/suggestions/recommendations if any and take appropriate follow-up action on such matters put forward by the organisations.
